
You recently requested that the Nova Scotia Department of Agriculture and Fisheries approve the Advanced.fst training program for use in the province of Nova Scotia to train food service and food retail employees in safe food handling.

Your letter of October 1, 2002, describes ADVANCED.fst as based on the ServSafe Serving Safe Food Coursebook (1995 National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation -NRAEF-publication) with material adapted to Canadian standards and reflects the Food Retail and Food Service Regulations and Code. The examination and instructor approval process follows the same criteria as required by the NRAEF for the ServSafe program.

The Food Safety Section of the Nova Scotia Department of Agriculture and Fisheries will acknowledge "ADVANCED.fst" as a training program for food service and food retail employees. Those employees holding valid certificates for ADVANCED.fst will be given the same credit and standing as those with ServSafe credentials.
