Re: BASICS.fst and ADVANCE.fst

Thank you for providing Brant County Health Unit with a copy of the BASICS.fst Food Safety Training in Canada program and the ADVANCED.fst Food Safety Training in Canada program. The course content and exam have been reviewed and evaluated and were found to satisfactorily meet the minimum course content and exam requirements of the Brant County Health Unit's mandatory food handler training protocol.

The Brant County Health Unit will recognize BASICS.fst and Advanced.fst as a Food Handler Certification Course. Participants successfully passing the BASICS.fst exam or the Advanced.fst exam will be recognized by the Brant County Health Unit as Certified Food Handlers. The food handler certification will only be recognized as valid for no longer than five years following the date of issuance, at which time food handlers will be required to re-certify by successfully passing a food safety certification exam.

It is a requirement of the Brant County Health Unit that all certified food handlers be able to show documented proof of certification upon request by Brant County Health Unit Environmental Health and Inspection Services staff.
