

Becoming A TrainCan® Food Safety Trainer – Requirements

The **first requirement** to become a registered trainer with TrainCan® is to achieve a 90% or greater mark on our ADVANCED.fst® manager level training exam. Once this is successfully completed, an application can be submitted for trainer status. The application form can be found at www.traincan.com under the button labeled “Forms and Administration”.

When submitting the application be sure to include the requested supplementary information. This includes details about completed courses, previous training experience and professional qualifications. This will speed up the review process at TrainCan®.

If this supporting information is deemed not sufficient by TrainCan®, then a Train-the-Trainer program will be required.
