**Foodservice Safety and Sanitation**

**Culinary Management, Chef Training, Apprentices  
Hospitality Management - Hotel & Restaurant  
Food & Beverage Service**

All programs include an on-line Basics.*fst* Foodservice Safety and Sanitation course HRT 121. Through self study on the internet (approx. 3 hrs), students will complete a series of modules regarding food safety and sanitation. Each student purchases a package at Gourmet Express which includes their own internet access code.

As per instructions, students must purchase the on-line package from Gourmet Express. This package explains the details of how to access the website, provides a specific log on password etc. For Hospitality Mgmt students the Basics.*fst* package is inside the manual package.

This course is primarily self-study – there are two in-class sessions only: see your timetable

1. **2nd week of course– Introduction to the topic and on-line course  
Student to hand-in blue scantron sheets**
2. **7th week of course – Exam: see schedule; ID is required for test**

- Students must submit their scantron sheets a minimum of 2 days prior to the scheduled test; hand-in the sheets to the instructor in the first class or to the receptionist at the School of HRT reception desk (C105)
- Students will not be allowed to complete the test in week 5, unless they have registered on line with Basics.*fst*.

**The Exam is your course mark:**

1. **For grades 74% or greater:** TrainCan Certificate and wallet card will be issued
2. **Grades between 60 – 73%:** This grade is recorded as your final mark. However you have the opportunity to re-write the exam to achieve the TrainCan Certification. If your rewrite results are 74%+ will you receive the certification but not a grade change. Your grade has been recorded based on the first exam and will not change.
3. **Grades between 50 – 59%:** A **rewrite** opportunity is available and is considered a supplemental test. As per school policy, this will be offered to those students between 50-59%, to have a supplemental opportunity to pass the course (maximum grade for supplemental tests is 60%). You will earn a certificate if you score 74% or greater on the re-write but your grade will be 60%.
  - There will be one re-write date, see the schedule. There is a re-write fee of \$25.00. Rewrite package can be purchased from Gourmet Express
  - You must reserve a space to re-write the exam at C105 at least one week prior to the re-write date scheduled.
4. **If your exam results are below 50%** and you will need to re-enrol in this course in the next semester – see your Program Coordinator.
